

Perisher Deploys ComOps for Ski Resort Risk Management

Sydney, 21 April 2010 – ComOps, a leading Australasian provider of business software products and services, today announced that Perisher, the southern hemisphere's largest ski resort, has selected the ComOps Salvus safety and incident management reporting software as part of an integrated resort-wide risk management program.

The ComOps Salvus solution will replace Perisher's existing manual Excel spreadsheet-based system for reporting safety incidents. The web-based solution will include dashboards for real-time reporting, analysis and management of employee safety and events.

Salvus also automates the management of occupational health, safety and risk information ensuring that organisations remain compliant with the latest legislation affecting their industries.

Perisher boosts its 140 permanent employees during the winter skiing season with a diverse workforce of more than 1,000 temporary contractor staff, often working in risk-prone jobs. These include ski instructors, lift operators, engineers, electricians, transport drivers, mechanics and ticket scanners. They also work in a large physical area across the length and breadth of the resort's 1,245 hectare expanse. In addition to 47 lifts, Perisher also operates a highly regulated Skitube Alpine Railway, which has its own specific requirements for safety.

"Perisher selected Salvus following a comprehensive market review. However, only Salvus had all the attributes that we were looking for including the ability to provide a one-stop shop for aggregation of information and an automated, scalable safety, incident and corrective actions management platform. Indeed, Salvus will provide us with an audit trail for managing incidents enabling us to enhance our overall safety culture," said Richard Tuck, General Manager, Systems Compliance and Resort Services, Perisher Blue Pty Ltd.

Perisher will use Salvus to record and analyse incidents and produce detailed web-based dashboard reports for management reviews which will compare performance, spot trends, identify weaknesses and act in cases where safety performance may not be up to the stringent levels required.



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“Despite the fact that we are a leisure facility, we are also a heavy engineering site with highly technical equipment operating in sometimes harsh climatic conditions.

Salvus gives us an opportunity to diligently and effectively manage risks by providing real-time reporting of where hazards are and strong visibility into real-time actions taken by individual managers. At any point in time, we can view at our fingertips, where the responsibilities lie to conclude an issue within the escalation protocols which Salvus provides.

Salvus will go live at Perisher by the end of April.
